This session will help you to use CiviMail – and the Civi extension Mosaico – to build better relationships with your contacts and members. The session will feature a step by step guide to creating a mailing in Mosaico. You will master personalising subject lines and mailing content and learn how to enhance the style and readability of your mailings. These practical tips are aimed at helping you to increase the number of contacts who open and engage with your mailings. We will explore real-world examples of ways to put our learning into action.
